

### The Tuesday Hearts Final Assembly

Quilt dimensions: 108.5 x 160 cm (43<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 64")

#### General instructions:

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm (1/4"), rounded to 15 mm (1/2") for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments. The dimensions in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances.

#### Materials and cutting:

The fabrics are 110 cm (44") wide.

- Grey fabric for inner strips and for the outer border
  - 1.3 m (1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>yd)
- Pink fabric for the central and setting squares
  - 10 x 20 cm (4" x 8")
- Backing and batting : 120 x 170 cm (48" x 68")

## Making the project:

### Diagram 1:

From the grey fabric, cut the following:

- 8 A strips of  $4 \times 26.5$  cm ( $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$ )
- 8 B strips of  $4 \times 21.5$  cm ( $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$ )
- 2 D strips de  $8 \times 54$  cm ( $3'' \times 21\frac{1}{2}''$ )

From the pink fabric:

- 4 C squares of  $4 \times 4$  cm ( $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$ )

Place your blocks, referring to the diagram 4. Make sure you place the block #16 (made by Bea) in the bottom centre.

When you are happy with your layout, sew carefully


Rows 1 & 3: one block on either side of a A strip

Row 2: one B strip on either side of a C square

Assemble those rows together in numerical order.

Repeat and sew one of these units on either side of a D strip.

You will obtain 2 units.



## Diagram 2:

From the grey fabric, cut the following:

- 2 E strips of 8 x 44 cm ( $3'' \times 17\frac{1}{2}''$ )
- 1 G strip of 8 x 93 cm ( $3'' \times 37''$ )
- 1 H rectangle of 26.5 x 53 cm ( $10\frac{1}{2}'' \times 21''$ )

From the pink fabric:

- 1 F square of 8 x 8 cm ( $3'' \times 3''$ )

To piece your quilt top together, sew:

Row 1 & 3: one of the previous units paying attention to the position of units

Row 2: one E strip on either side of an F square

Row 4: the G strip

Row 5: one block on either side of the H rectangle

Assemble those rows together in numerical order.





### Diagram 3:

From the grey fabric, cut the following:


- Two I strips of 10 x 93 cm (4" x 37")
- Three 10 x 110 cm (4" x 44") strips : assemble these strips together and trim them to obtain two J strips of 10 x 161.5 cm (4" x 64 1/2")

Assemble your I strips at the top and bottom.

Complete the final border with one J strip on the right and left.

Appliqué Bea's block (it is centred on H rectangle) using the traditional method: baste the seam allowances of the border hexagons to the back. Then, appliqué this block with small invisible stitches all around.

Bloc Block N°16



### Finish:

Layer your work with the batting and backing.

Quilt as desired.

To complete the project stitch a bias binding all around.
