

Block 10 – Emma Neman

General instructions :

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ "), rounded to 15 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments. The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances. For the templates, add a seam allowance of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") all around.

Cutting key:

☒: Square cut on the two diagonals

For those using the traditional cutting method, note that you will find:

- the templates on the pattern; add seam allowances to them
- the quantities **in bold** in the Cutting section

Cutting :

- From an assortment of four pink fabrics:
 - one A octagon of each fabric
- From one fabric, raspberry semi-solid, cut the following:
 - one 4.5 cm ($1\frac{3}{4}$ ") B square
 - four D pieces
- From one black and white fabric:
 - one 7.7 cm (3 ") square, ☒ to yield **four C triangles**
- From one white fabric with small flowers:
 - four E pieces

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Assembly :

Diagram 1: Stitch one A octagon to either side of the B square.

Stitch one C triangle to either side of the two remaining A octagons and join them to the top and bottom of the previous unit.

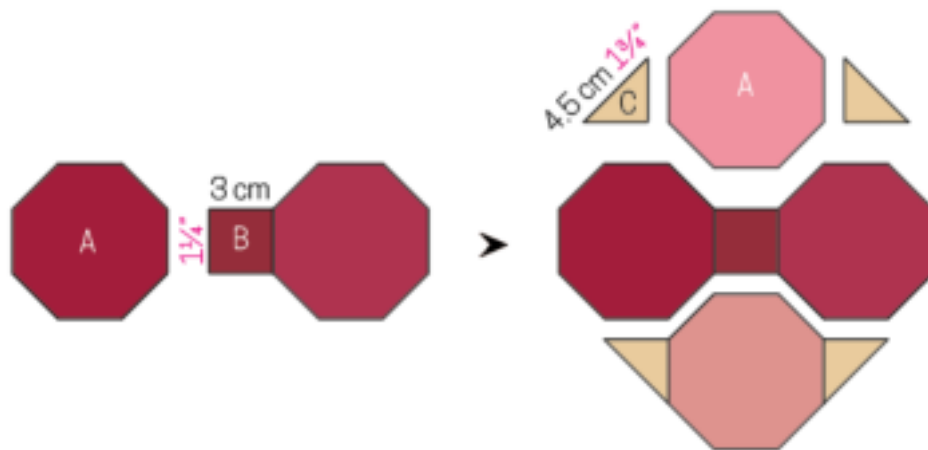


Diagram 2: Stitch one E piece to two opposite sides of the previous unit. Stitch one D piece to either side of the remaining E pieces and complete your block.
