

Block 21 – Anne Varley

General instructions :

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ "), rounded to 15 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments. The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances, except for those diagrams that specify "*Seam allowances included". For the appliqués, add your preferred seam allowance around the templates.

Cutting :

- From one pink fabric for the background, cut the following:
 - one 27.5 cm (11") A square; extra fabric is allowed when cutting to facilitate working the appliqués
- From one pink stripe fabric:
 - one heart
- From an assortment of beige and pink fabrics:
 - six leaves

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Assembly :

Diagram 1: Mark a 25 x 25 cm (10" x 10") square on the right side of the A square. Using a light source, transfer the motif outlines.

Work the appliqués using the traditional method as follows: pin or baste the heart in place on the background square, turning your seam allowance to the back (on both the outer and inner edges of the heart).

Then work the appliqué of the outer edge and the reverse appliqué of the inner edge with small invisible stitches.

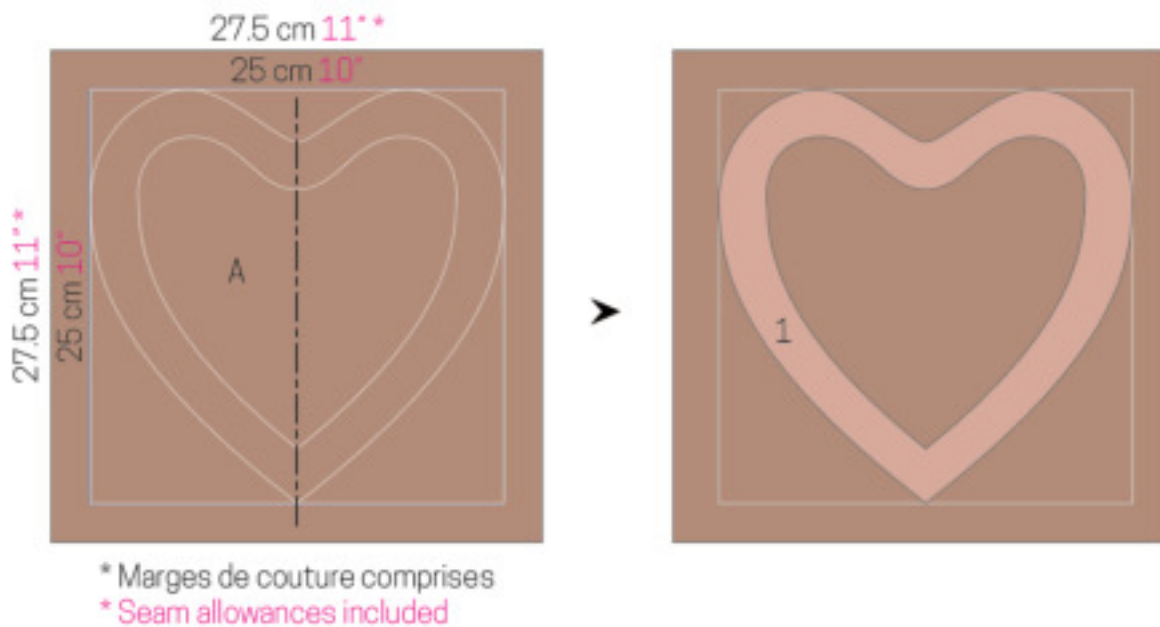


Diagram 2: Add the leaf appliqués to either side of the heart, in the desired order. Recut the appliqué block to 26.5 x 26.5 cm (10¹/₂" x 10¹/₂"), seam allowances included.

You can vary the block by adding a bee and an appliqué hexagon.
