

## Block 28 – Renée Ferré

### General instructions :

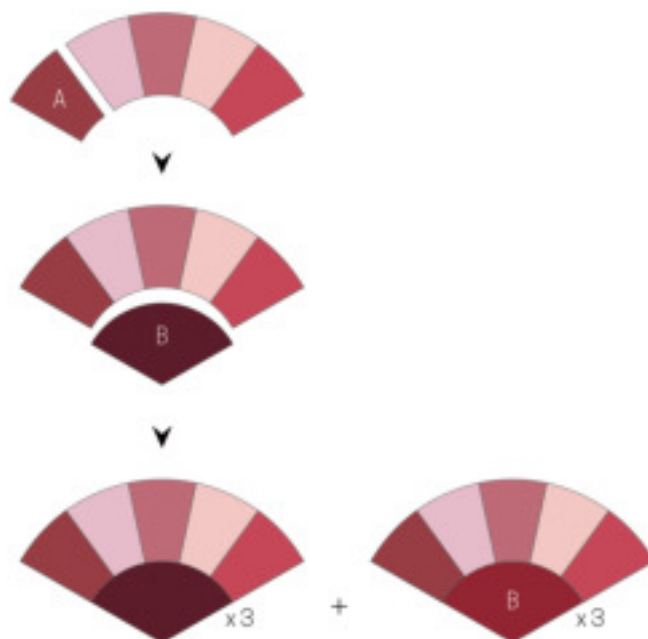
The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ), rounded to 15 mm ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ) for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments. The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances. For the templates, add a seam allowance of 7 mm ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ) all around.

### Cutting :

- From one assortment of five pink fabrics, cut the following:
  - six A pieces from each fabric
- From one dark red fabric:
  - three B pieces, transferring the reference marks indicated on the template
  - one 26.5 cm ( $10\frac{1}{2}$ " ) E square
- From one red semi-solid fabric:
  - three B pieces, transferring the reference marks indicated on the template
- From one beige fabric:
  - one C circle
- From one red fabric:
  - one D circle

### Assembly :

**Diagram 1:** Stitch together one A piece in each of the five pink fabrics. Insert one dark red B piece, aligning the reference marks with the base of the A pieces. In the same way make three identical fans and three more with one red B piece.

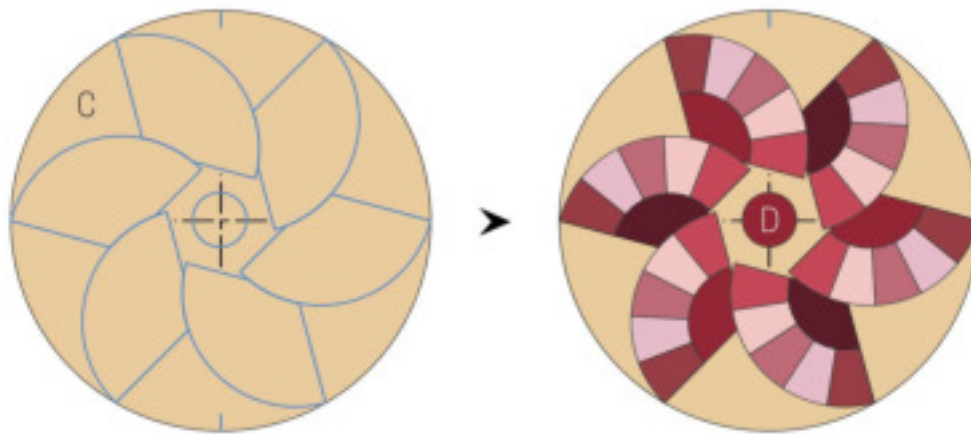

**Diagram 2:** Transfer the marking of the outer edge of the fans onto your C circle, as well as the reference marks indicated on the template.

Position your fans as indicated on the diagram, alternating them; pin or baste them on the C circle, turning your seam allowance to the back. Then appliqué them using the traditional method, with small invisible stitches.

In the same way, add the D circle in the centre.



**Diagram 3:** Mark the medians of your E square and place the appliqué circle, aligning the reference marks with the medians. Appliqué the circle with small invisible stitches on the background square.
