

Block 45 – Brigitte Giblin

General instructions :

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ "), rounded to 15 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments. The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances, except for those diagrams that specify "*Seam allowances included". For the templates, add a seam allowance of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") all around.

Cutting :

- From one pink fabric with blue print, fussy cut the following:
 - six A pieces
- From one pink fabric, fussy cut:
 - six identical A hexagons, centred on one motif
 - six other identical A hexagons, slightly shifting the motif
- From one purple fabric with large flowers, fussy cut:
 - eighteen identical A hexagons
- From one fabric with small flowers, fussy cut:
 - twenty-two C diamonds, each centred on one flower
- From one white fabric with polka dots for the background:
 - one 27.5 cm (11 ") D square

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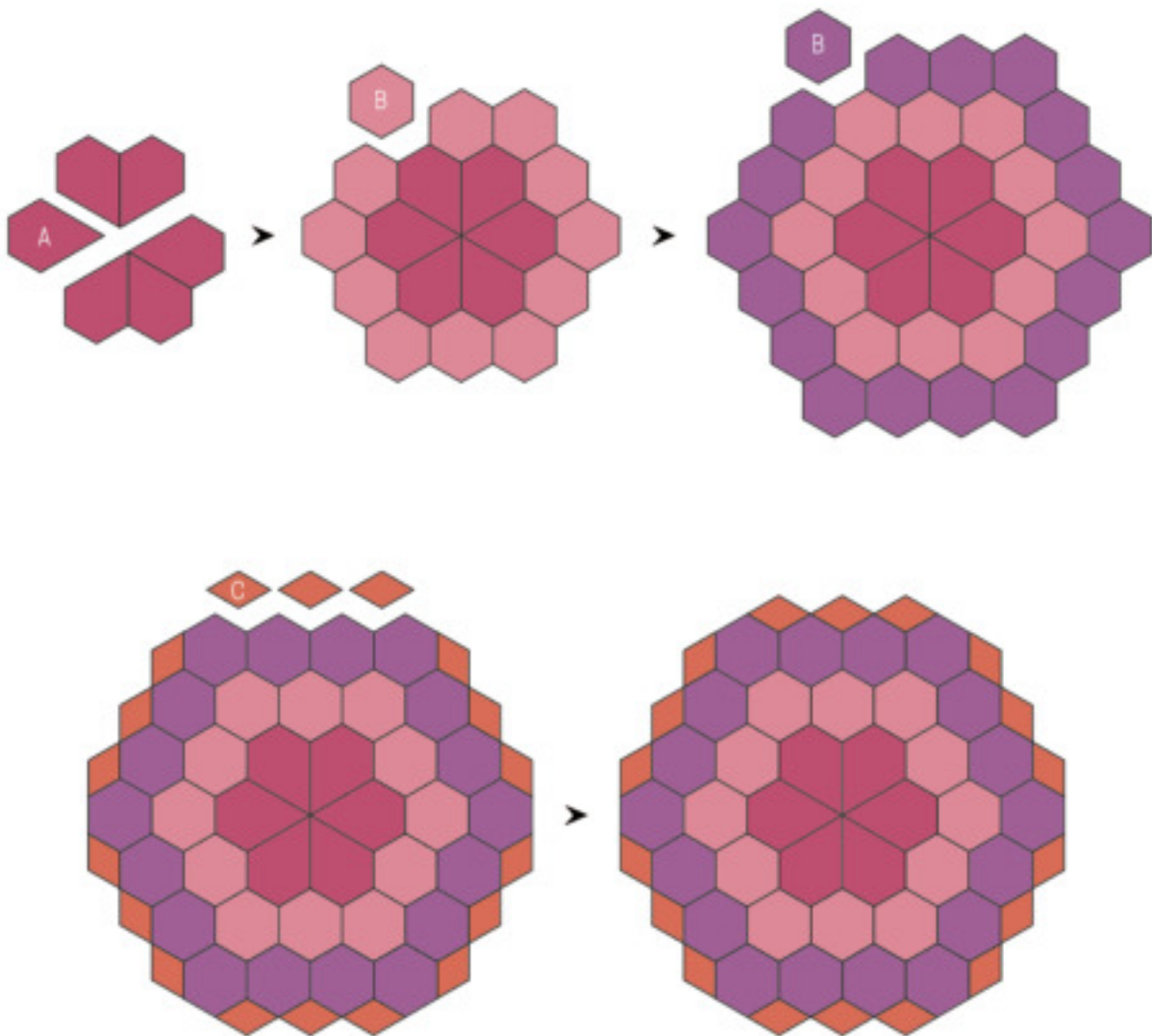
Assembly :

Diagram 1: Baste your fabric A pieces, B hexagons and C diamonds on the corresponding paperboard templates for English paper piecing.

Stitch together three A pieces. Repeat and join these units.

With the twelve pink A hexagons, alternating them, stitch once around the previous unit. Stitch a second time around with eighteen purple A hexagons and complete with three C diamonds on each side of the unit obtained.

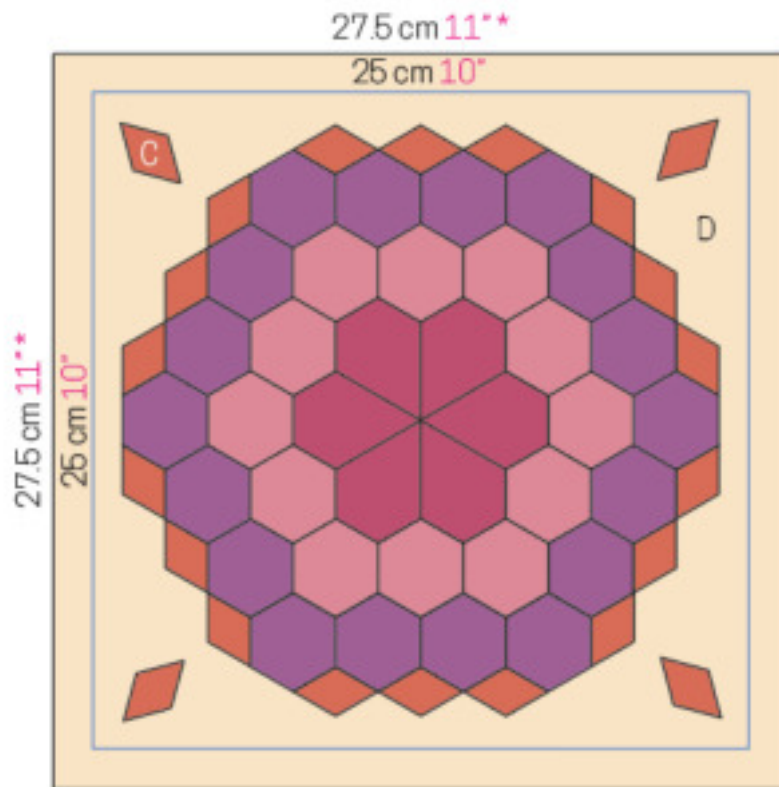
Press the unit and remove the paper templates.



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Diagram 2: Centre your unit on the D background square and appliqué the unit with small invisible stitches on the square. Press and remove the templates of the last four C diamonds and appliqué them in the corners.

Recut the block to 26.5 x 26.5 cm ($10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ "), seam allowances included.
