

## Block 47 – Reiko Kato

### General instructions :

The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances, except for those diagrams that specify “\*Seam allowances included”.

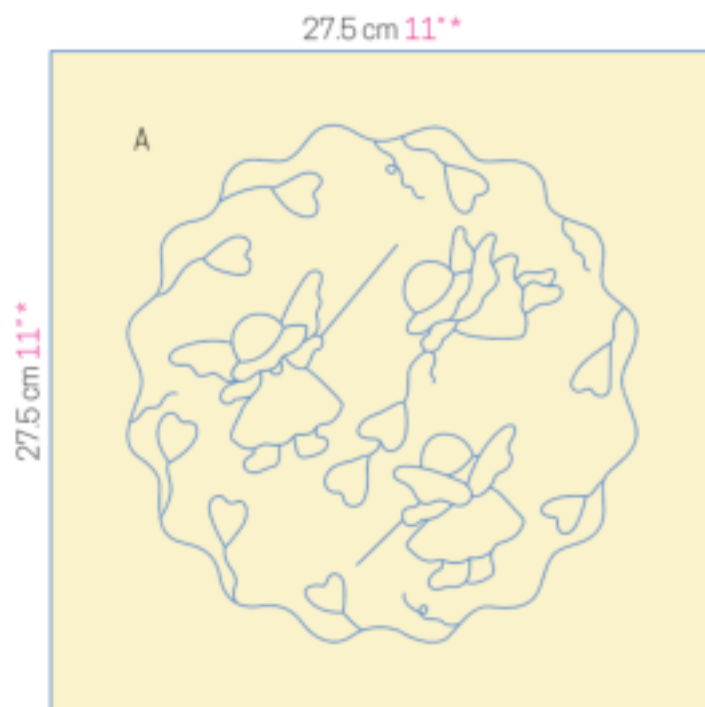
**For the appliqués,** add your preferred seam allowance around the templates.

### Cutting :

- From one beige fabric (Toile de Jouy-type) for the background of the centre medallion, cut the following:
  - one 27.5 cm (11”) A square; extra fabric is allowed when cutting to facilitate working the appliqués
- From one pink fabric with polka dots:
  - one 27.5 cm (11”) A square; extra fabric is allowed when cutting to facilitate working the appliqués
- From an assortment of red and pink fabrics:
  - the various appliqué elements, using the templates

### Assembly :

**Diagram 1:** Using a light source, transfer the motif outlines of the centre medallion to the right side of the beige A square.

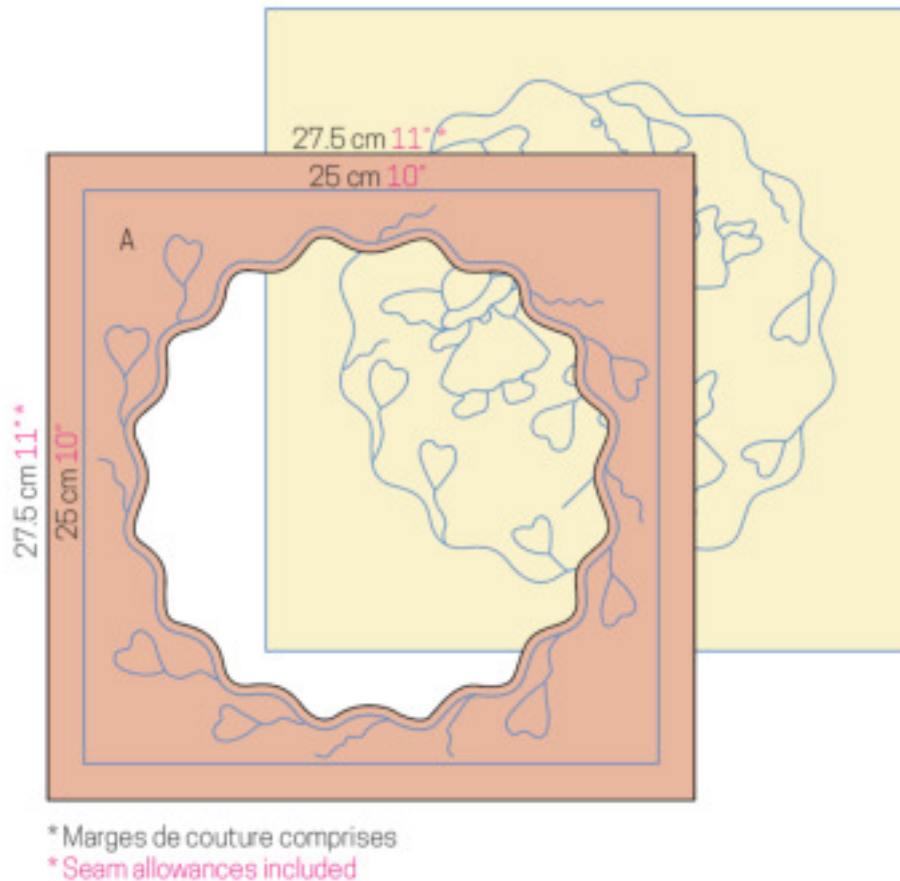


\* Marges de couture comprises

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**Diagram 2:** Transfer the outer-medallion motifs to the pink A square. Cut out the centre, retaining a seam allowance all around. Place the pink square, wrong side toward right side and edge to edge, on the beige A square. Work the reverse appliqué of the wavy edge, turning your seam allowance to the back, using small running stitches. Cut away the excess fabric on the back.



**Diagram 3:** Then work the appliqués using the traditional method, in the numerical order of the templates. Referring to the pattern, work the embroidery indicated on the pattern. Recut the appliqué block to 26.5 x 26.5 cm ( $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ "), seam allowances included.
