

Block 51 – Jessica Wheelahan

General instructions :

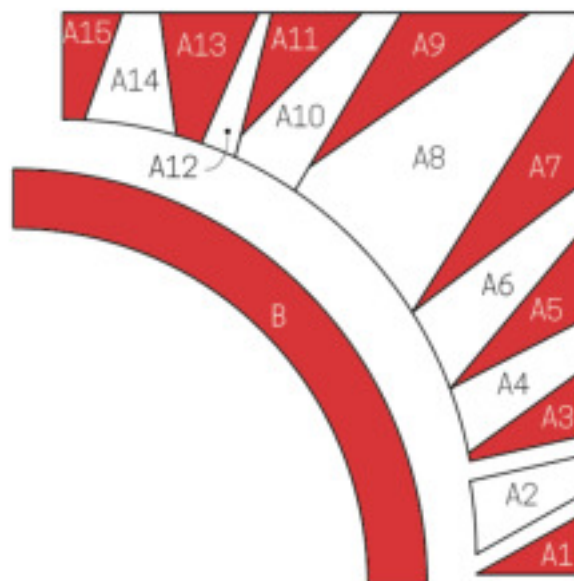
The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ "), rounded to 15 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments. The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances. For the templates, add a seam allowance of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") all around.

Cutting :

- From one solid red fabric, cut the following:
 - pieces A1, A3, A5, A7, A9, A11, A13 and A15
 - one B piece
- From one white fabric:
 - pieces A2, A4, A6, A8, A10, A12 and A14
- From one assortment of pink and red fabrics:
 - pieces C1 to C11
 - pieces D1 to D8
 - one E piece
- From one pink fabric:
 - one 7 x 15.5 cm ($2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 6") F strip
 - one 7 x 21 cm ($2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $8\frac{1}{4}$ ") G strip
- From a second red fabric:
 - one 7 x 21 cm ($2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $8\frac{1}{4}$ ") G strip
 - one 7 x 26.5 cm ($2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ ") H strip

Assembly :

Diagram 1: Stitch red pieces A1, A3, A5, A7, A9, A11, A13 and A15 with white pieces A2, A4, A6, A8, A10, A12 and A14, alternating them. Add the B piece to this unit.



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Diagram 2: Following the same instructions, assemble the C and D arcs using the different pieces that compose the arcs. Stitch them to the previous unit and complete with the E piece.

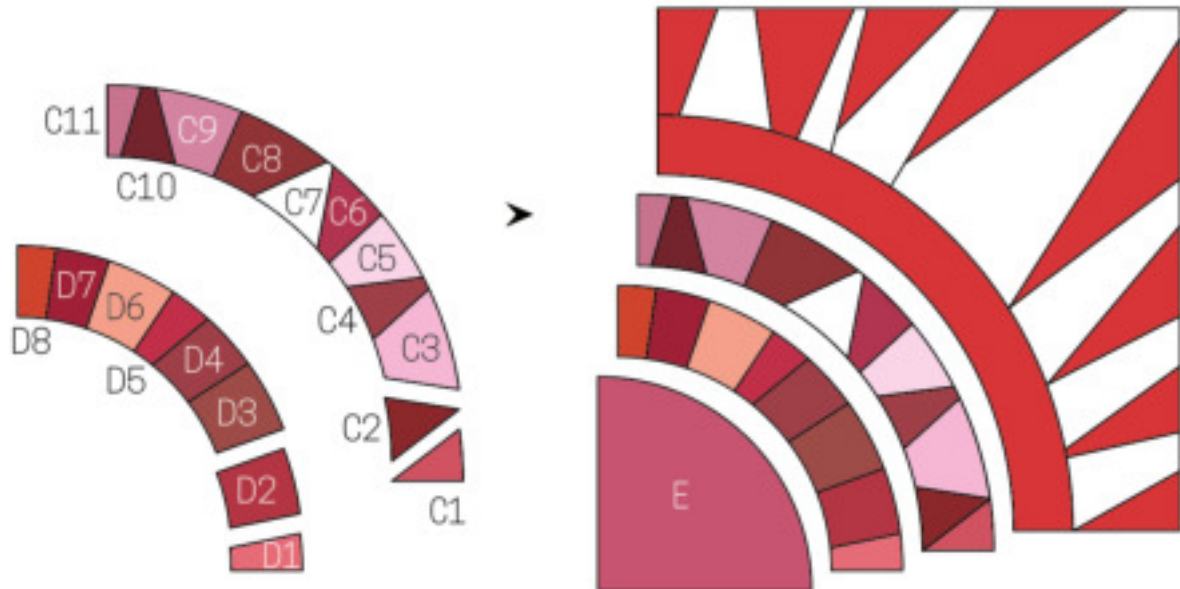


Diagram 3: Stitch one F piece to the bottom and the pink G strip to the left side. Complete the outer border with the red G strip on the right and the H strip on top.
