

## Block 56 – Liza Prior Lucy

### General instructions :

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ), rounded to 15 mm ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ) for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments. The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances, except for those diagrams that specify "\*Seam allowances included". For those using the traditional cutting method, note that you will find:

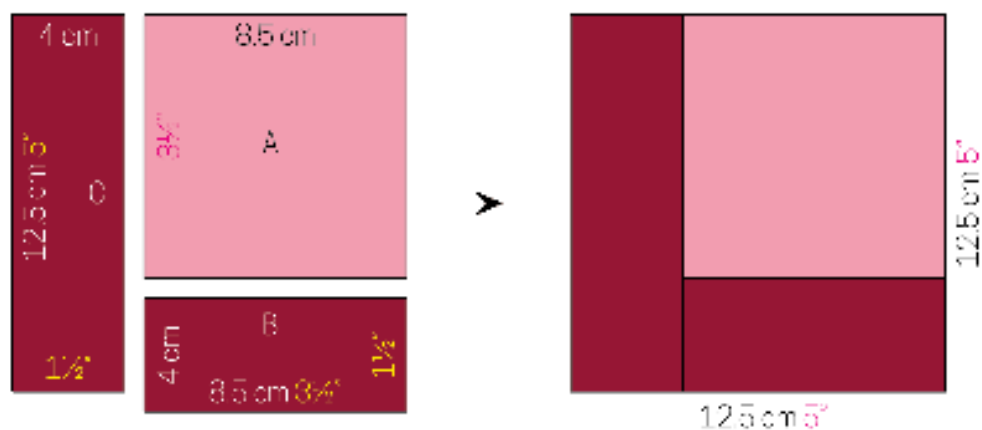
- the templates on the pattern; add seam allowances to them
- the quantities in **bold** in the Cutting section

### Cutting :

- From one pink fabric, cut the following:
  - one 10 cm (4") A square
  - one 6 cm ( $2\frac{1}{2}$ " ) square → **one E piece**
  - four 5.5 cm (2") squares → **four G triangles**
  - one I piece and one I' piece (reverse template I)
  - one K triangle
  - two 4 x 10 cm ( $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4") L rectangles
- From one red fabric:
  - one 5.5 x 10 cm (2" x 4") B rectangle
  - two 5.5 x 14 cm (2" x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " ) C rectangles
  - four 2.5 cm (1") squares → **four D triangles**
  - two 5.5 x 6 cm (2" x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " ) F rectangles
  - two 5.5 x 14 cm (2" x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " ) rectangles → **two H pieces**
  - one J piece and one J' piece (reverse template J)
  - three 4 x 10 cm ( $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4") L rectangles

### Assembly :

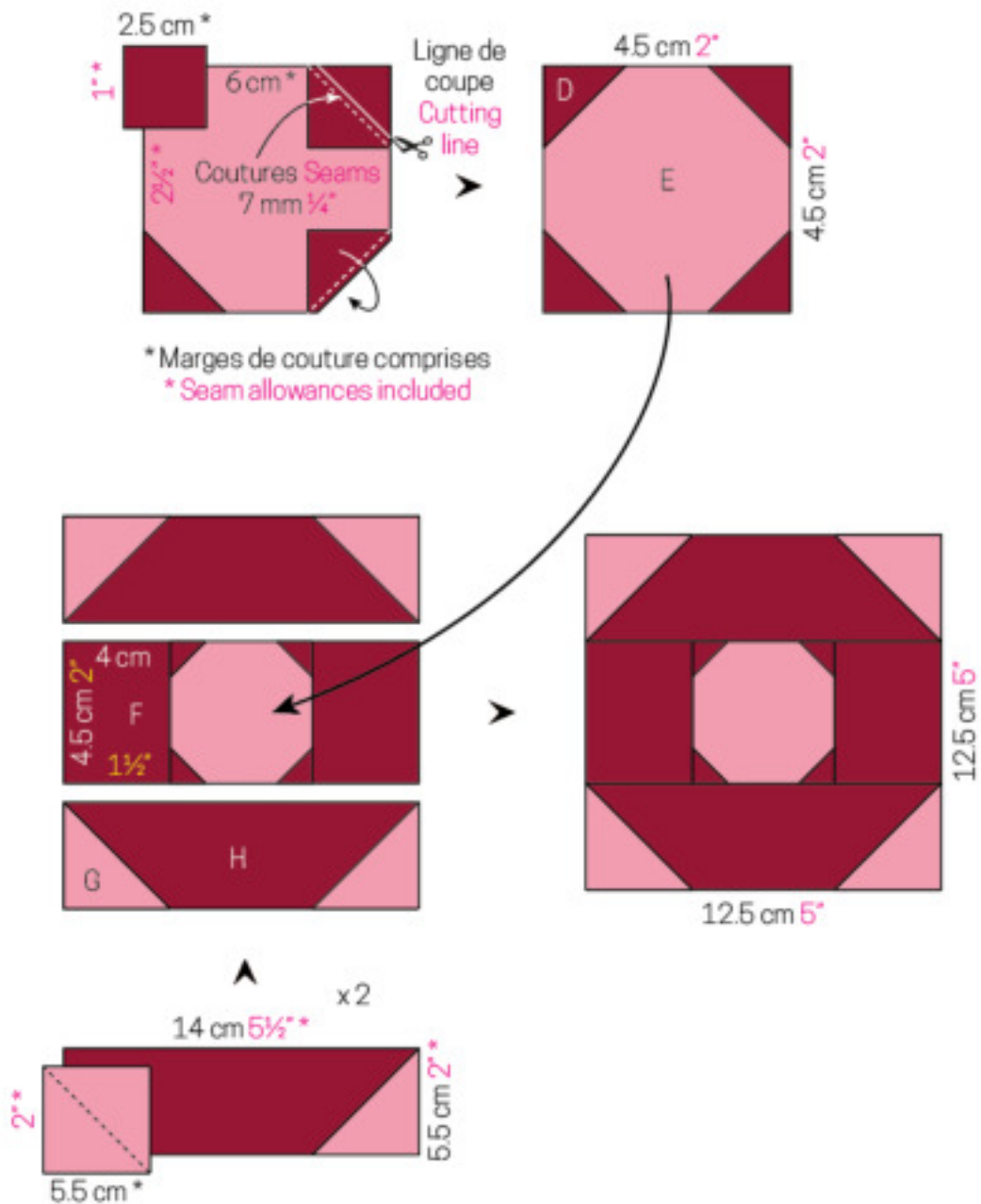
**Diagram 1:** Stitch the B rectangle below the A square and add one C rectangle to the left side to make the letter "L".



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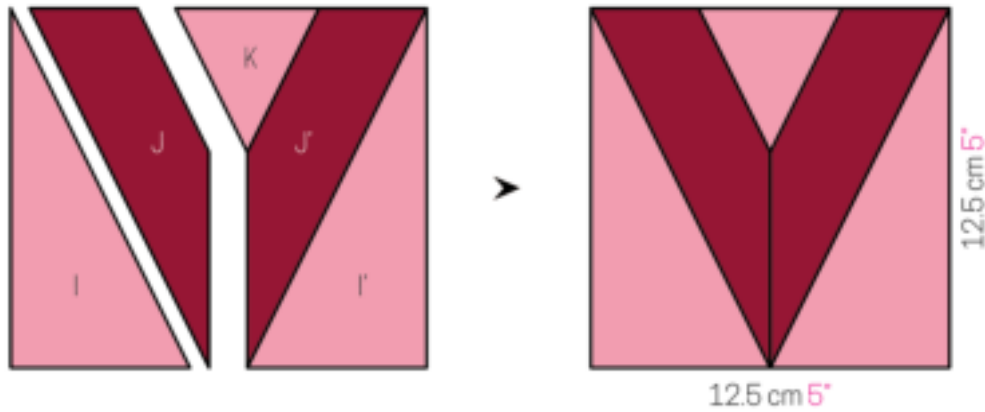
**Diagram 2:** Place four small red 2.5 cm (1") squares, right sides together, in the corners of the pink 6 cm (2½") square. Stitch along the diagonals of each small square and cut away the excess fabric at 7 mm (¼"). Stitch one F rectangle to either side of this unit.

With two pink 5.5 cm (2") squares and one red 5.5 x 14 cm (2" x 5½") rectangle, make one unit. Repeat and join these units to the top and bottom to make the letter "O".

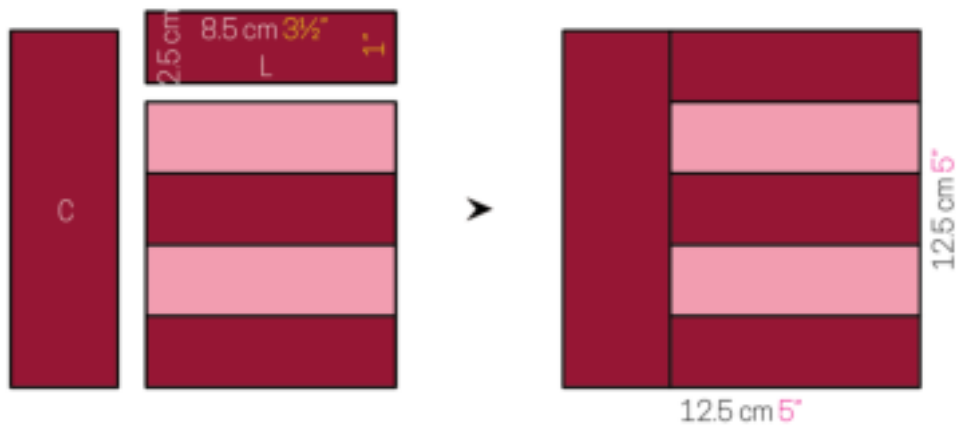


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**Diagram 3:** Stitch the I' triangle to the J' piece. Add the K triangle. Join the I triangle and the J piece. Add this unit to the previous unit to make the letter "V".



**Diagram 4:** Stitch together the three red L rectangles and the two pink L rectangles, alternating them. Complete the letter "E" with the remaining C rectangle on the left side.



**Diagram 5:** Referring to the diagram, stitch the letters together in twos and join them.
