

Block 73 – Jo Colwill

General instructions:

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm $(^{1}/_{4}")$, rounded to 15 mm $(^{1}/_{4}")$ for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments. The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances, except for those diagrams that specify "*Seam allowances included". For the appliqués, add your preferred seam allowance around the templates.


Cutting:

- From one grey fabric for the background and from one red fabric with checks, cut the following:
 - o one 27.5 cm (11") A square; extra fabric is allowed when cutting to facilitate working the appliqués
- From one pink fabric:
 - o circle 1
 - o four of heart 5
- From scraps of pink fabrics
 - o the other appliqué elements, using the templates

Assembly:

Diagram 1: Mark one 25 x 25 cm (10" x 10") square on the right side of the grey A square. Using a light source, transfer the motif outlines. Embroider the map of the world on circle 1 and appliqué it, using the traditional method, working small running stitches on the A background square.

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- * Marges de couture comprises
- * Seam allowances included

Diagram 2: Transfer the outline of piece 2 onto the red-checked A square. Cut away then work reverse appliqué, using small running stitches throughout, on the A background square.

Trim away the excess fabric on the back.

Add the other appliqués as well as the embroidered text.

Recut the appliqué block to 26.5 x 26.5 cm $(10^1/2" \times 10^1/2")$, seam allowances included.
