

Block 80 – Anne-helene Nedelec

General instructions :

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ "), rounded to 15 mm ($\frac{1}{2}$ ") for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments.

The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances, except for those diagrams that specify "Seam allowances included".

For the templates, add a seam allowance of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") all around.

For the appliqués, add your preferred seam allowance around the templates.

Cutting :

Number your pieces for easier identification.

- From Fabric 1, red, cut the following:
 - one 17.5 cm ($6\frac{3}{4}$ ") A square; extra fabric is allowed when cutting to facilitate working the appliqués
- From Fabric 2, beige with line print, fussy cut and centred on one motif:
 - two 2.5 x 16.5 cm ($\frac{7}{8}$ " x $6\frac{1}{4}$ ") B strips
 - two 2.5 x 18.5 cm ($\frac{7}{8}$ " x 7") C strips
- From Fabric 3, red with large flowers, fussy cut:
 - the motifs chosen to compose your bouquet
- From Fabric 4, red with flowers:
 - one E piece
 - one G piece
- From one Fabric 5, dark red:
 - two F pieces

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Assembly :

Diagram 1: Mark one 15 x 15 cm ($5\frac{3}{4}$ " x $5\frac{3}{4}$ ") square on the right side of the A square.

Position and pin the different pieces cut from your fabric to make the bouquet of your choice.

Work the appliqués using the traditional method, turning your seam allowance to the back and using small invisible stitches.

Recut the appliqué block to 16.5 x 16.5 cm ($6\frac{1}{4}$ " x $6\frac{1}{4}$ "), seam allowances included. Stitch one B strip to the bottom and top. Complete the inner border on the left and right sides with one C strip on each side.

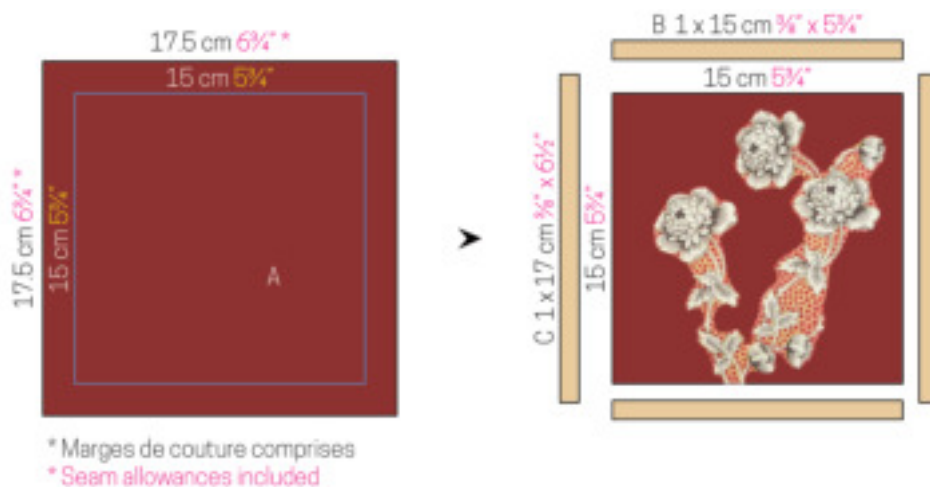


Diagram 2: Stitch the D strip to the top of the previous unit.

Stitch one F piece to the E piece. Add this unit to the left side and the H strip to the bottom.

Stitch the remaining F strip to the G piece. Add this unit to the right side, to complete the outer border.
