When interviewing artists over these many years, I am often struck by the richness of their life and Caroline's is a true adventure! So here is a little glimpse of the life and work of this remarkable woman and artist.

No, she did not take the usual route of art school or family tradition, but textiles have always made a strong impression on Caroline, particularly in Afghanistan, where her parents worked in the 1970s. In the markets of Kabul she remembers row upon row of pleated silk bakkhas and richly embroidered dresses which she has always regretted not being able to buy.

Caroline had wanted to be a singer from childhood and trained as an opera singer at the Royal College of Music and the Paris Conservatoire and met her husband, Jonathan, on a course for singers and accompanists. Sadly, an operation on her jaw forced her to re-think her career and she qualified as a lawyer while working for an investment bank in the City.
