

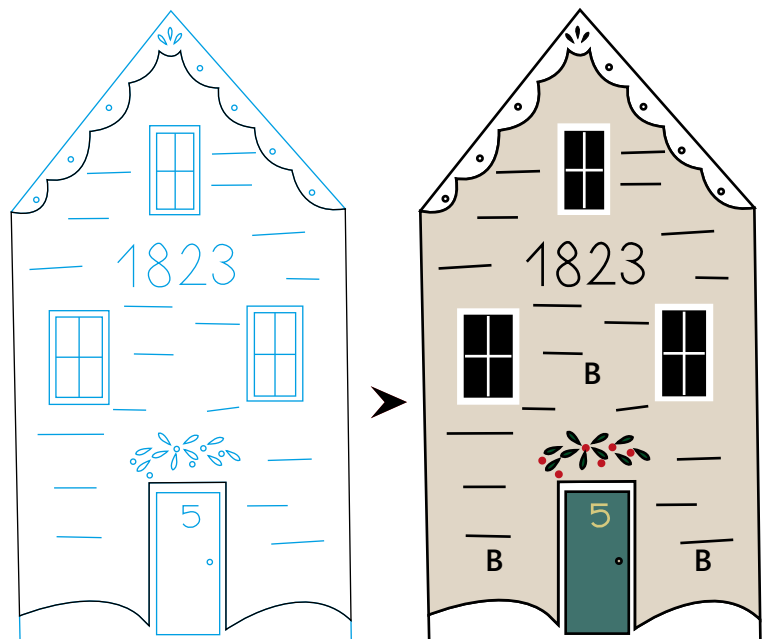


# XmasbyQuiltmania avec le P'tit Bûcheron

## Part 2: houses from 5 to 8

### House 5 :

Following Blandine Delépine's advice, paint the house. Allow to dry completely between painting operations. Add snow on the roof, at the bottom of the house and around the door. Paint the windows and door, then the bars and window frames. Line the walls of the house to imitate wood, and add any decorations you like (frieze above the door and at the edge of the roof, year of construction and snowflakes). Paint the number on the door and sew on the chosen buttons.

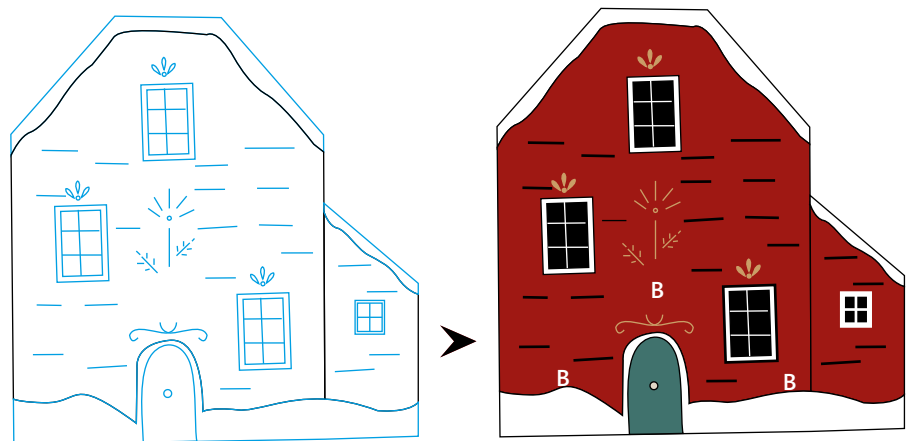


### House 6 :

Paint the walls and the lean-to. Paint the snow at the bottom of the house, then the door and its handle and finally the windows, the bars and frames. Add friezes above the windows and door. Finish with the roof and a few snowflakes.

Sew on the buttons.

If you prefer, you can paint the number on the house.

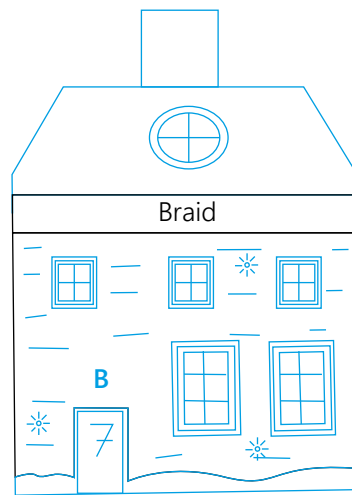

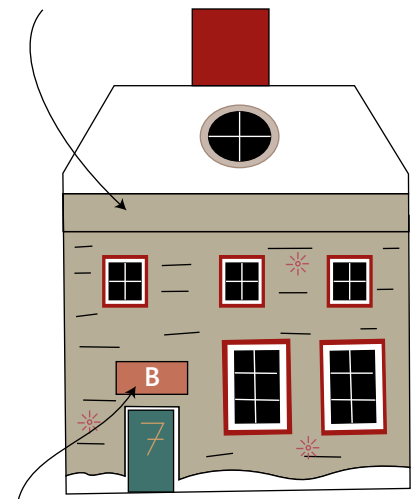
## House 7 :

Proceed in the same way as for the previous house, but add the 1.2 cm ( $\frac{1}{2}$ " ) wide braid between the roof and the body of the house, folding and gluing the ends to the back, and paint it in the color of the house. Paint the number on the door.

Paint a few lines on the to represent boards and snowflakes. Glue a rectangle of tartan fabric over the door and sew the chosen button on top.



1.2 cm ( $\frac{1}{2}$ " ) braid x width of house + returns

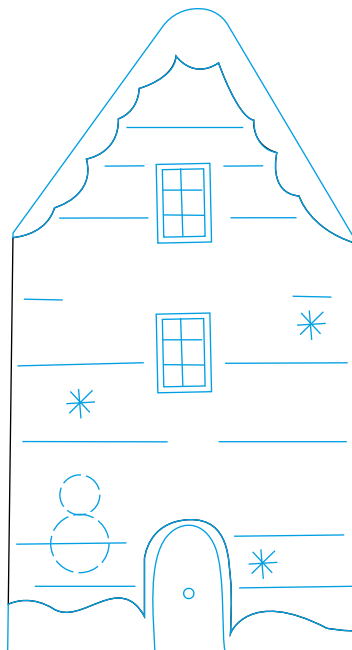

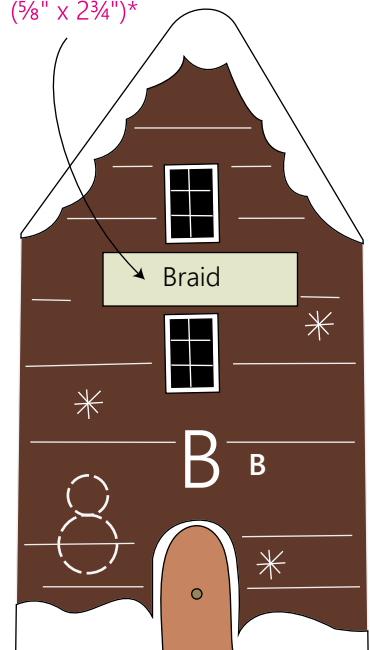
Rectangle of raw fabric  
1 x 2 cm ( $\frac{3}{8}$ " x  $\frac{3}{4}$ " )

## House 8 :

Paint the house, the snow below and on the roof, and the other painted decorations: windows, door, a few lines for the boards. Make a recess at both ends of the braid and attach it with a few invisible stitches, between the two windows. Add snowflakes, stars and paint the number. Sew on the buttons.



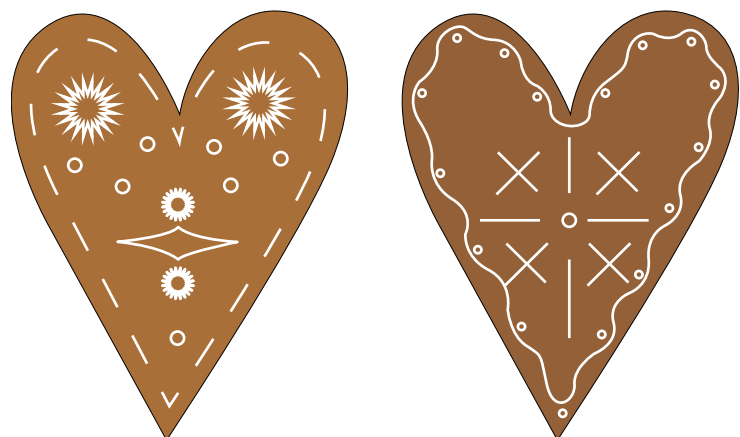
Embroidered braid (+seams allowance) 1.5 x 7 cm\*  
( $\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " )\*

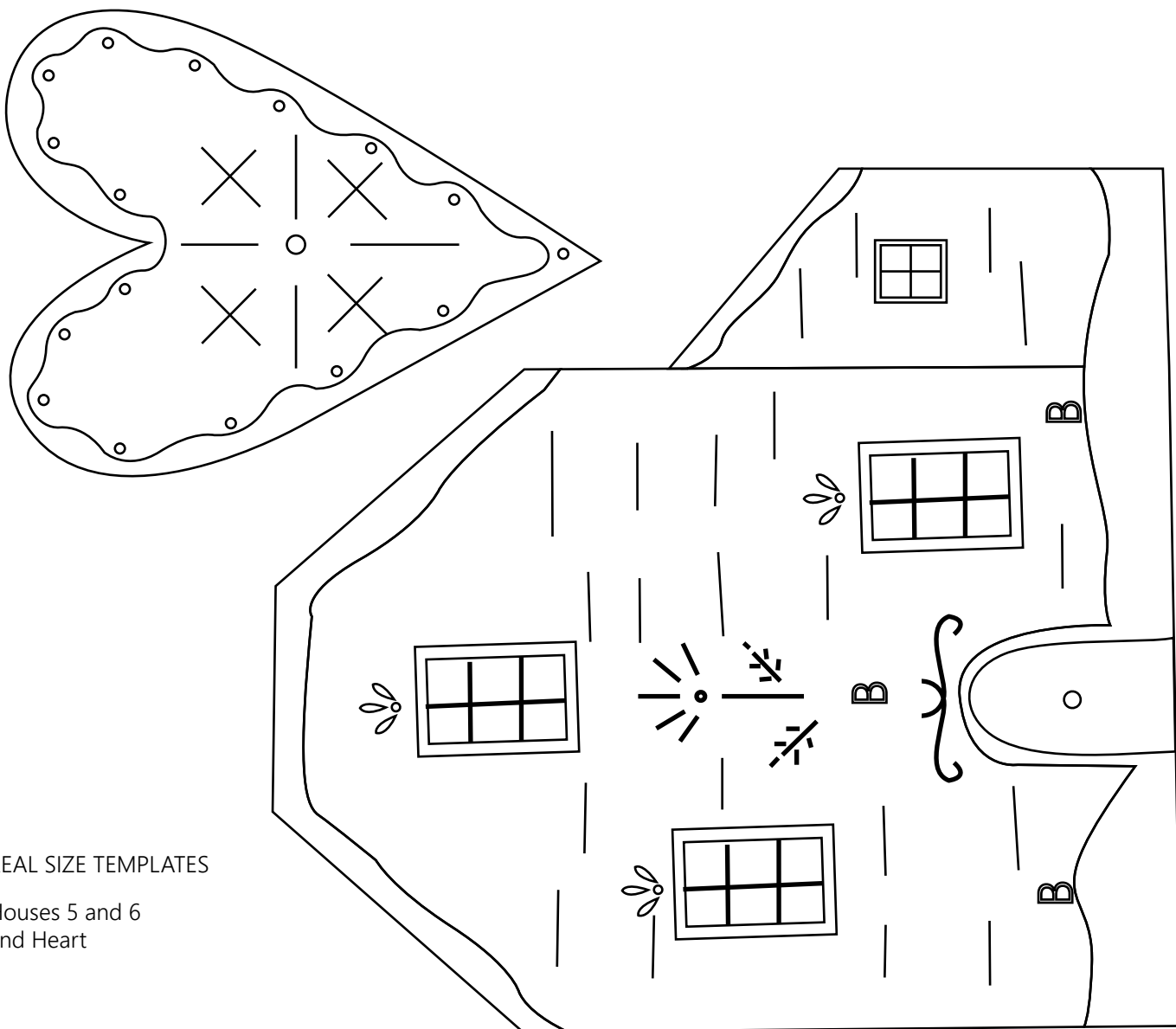

## The hearts :

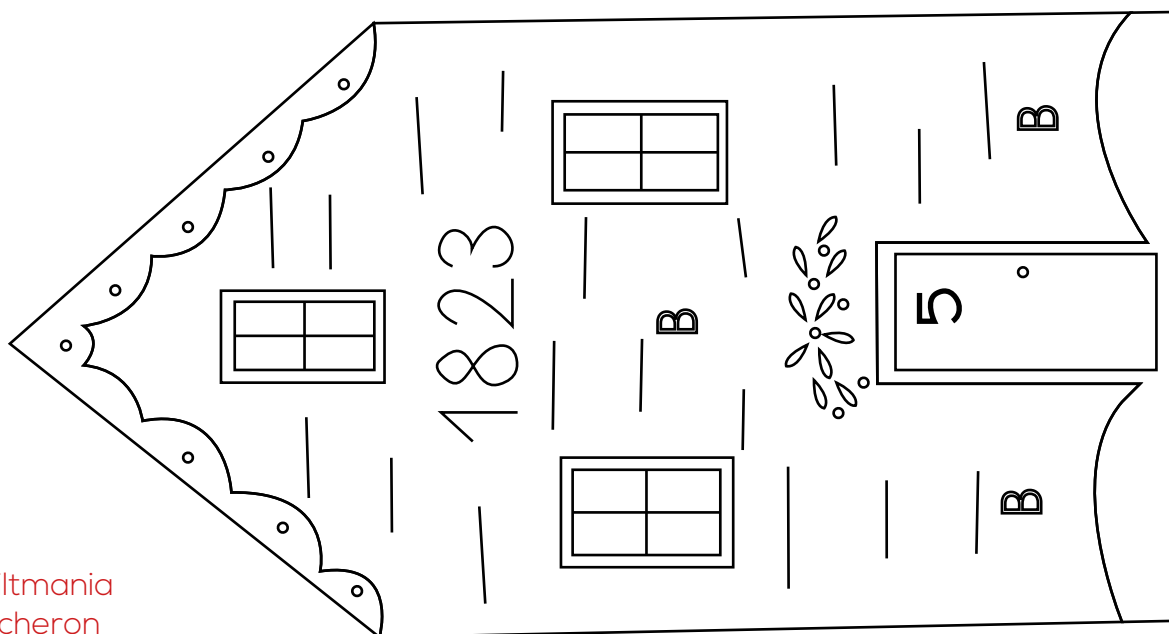
They're made in the same way as the houses: transfer the outline to the fabric folded in half, sew on the outline leaving an opening, glue the Vliseline, cut the excess fabric 5 mm ( $\frac{3}{16}$ " ) from the stitching, turn over, close the opening and paint the hearts and their decorations.



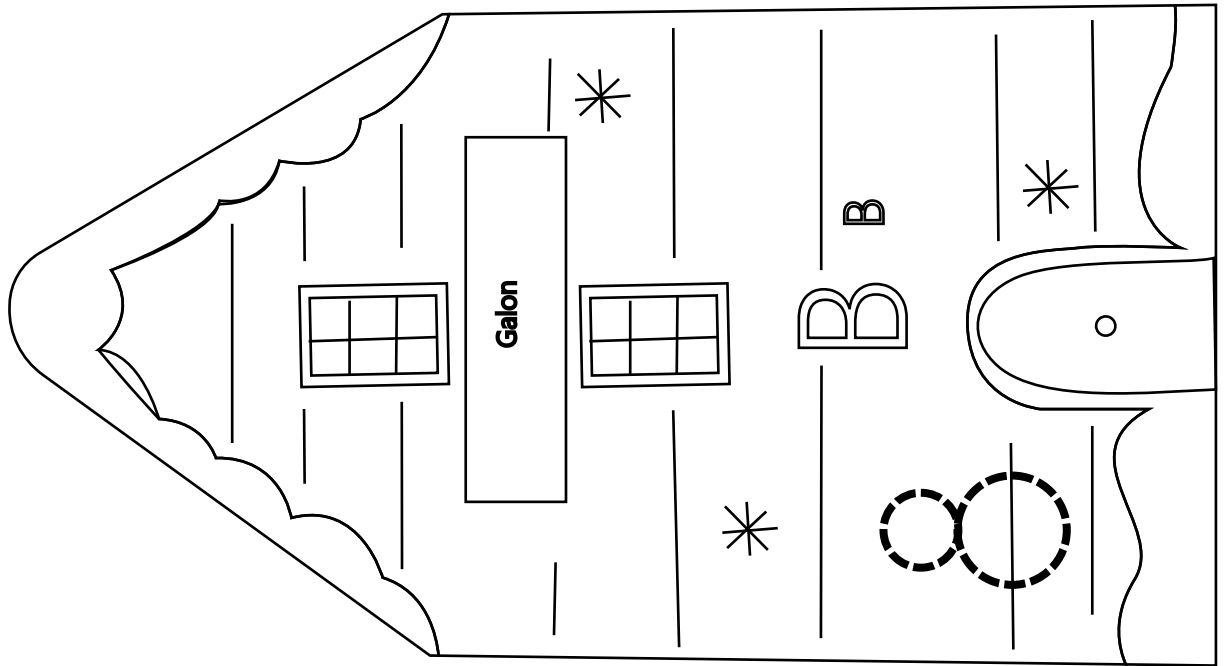
